## Lockdown Level Three. *Status quo* to be maintained

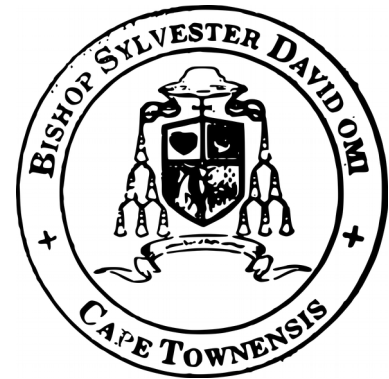
Further to our last directives issued on 29<sup>th</sup> December 2020 we have taken note of the State President's statement on 11<sup>th</sup> January 2021 which states *inter alia*: "It is necessary that we keep the Alert Level 3 measures in place until we have passed the peak of new infections and we are certain that the rate of transmission has fallen enough to allow us to safely ease the current restrictions".

It is therefore necessary to maintain the directives issued on 29<sup>th</sup> December 2020 – attached for easy reference and to do all we can to promote the behaviour changes needed to minimise infections. It must be emphasized that at this time only funerals will be permitted and even here all the necessary safety precautions will have to be followed. Unfortunately we cannot give a cut off date for these measures but will issue a further directive as soon as circumstances change.
