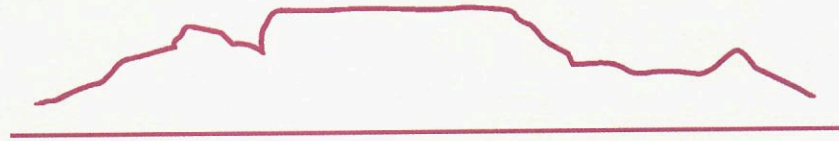




# Archdiocese of Cape Town



Dear Bishop, Monsignor, Father, Deacon, Sister, Brother

Consequent to the President's speech ending the State of Disaster, the following amendments are made to my letter of 1st April 2022 regarding Covid restrictions:

1. **Funerals:** The same restrictions as other gatherings now also apply to funerals, i.e. 50% capacity of the venue, provided there is safe social distancing (one metre), and the maximum numbers of 1000 for indoor and 2000 for outdoor, if vaccination/PCR negative results are not required. Night vigils are presumably once again allowed.

2. **The health questionnaire** and record of attendees are no longer necessary and no records need to be kept.

This makes all of our lives much easier. As you know, new health regulations will be published soon, and the situation will be re-evaluated in terms of those regulations.
